

## CLARIFICATIONS

The material presented here is presently based on interpretations of the regulation text as available until June 1, 2007. It is expected that over the coming 1-2 years, a more consolidated understanding of the REACH regulation will be developed among the many stakeholders now heavily involved with preparing themselves for the regulation. New technical guidelines will also be developed.

The following is a list of important changes since the E-learning was implemented:

2. The map of EU is used as background illustration for several important points. Countries belonging to EU are shown in blue except Rumania and Bulgaria. This does not indicate that these countries are not part of EU, but is a mistake in the illustration.
3. At the end of 2007 and beginning of 2008, a voice problem of the flash files contained in teaching modules was observed. It was related to the release of a new version of the Adobe Flash Player Active X, and was repaired by installing new updated flash files on the eREACH web-site.

The flash files included on the CD-version of the eREACH have also been generated by the previous version of the Adobe Flash Player ActiveX. However, in this case, the previous version of the flash Player program is included on the CD, and should still be used in connection with running the eREACH from the CD.
